How often must our equipment be certified?

In accordance with the National Code of Practice for the Prevention of Falls & the Workplace Health & Safety Regulation Sep 2008, permanently installed systems must be inspected and certified not less than 6 monthly.

All associated PPE requires 3 to 6 monthly inspection depending on the item. We can track and monitor the currency for all your systems and/or associated equipment and assist you to establish registers of all your equipment.
